



# In-Studio Birthday Party Info Sheet

## **Arrival:**

You can arrive to set up **20** minutes prior to your party time. The lobby will be set up for you, with one table against the wall and 2 or 3 rectangular tables centered, with folding chairs around each, depending on the number of guests.

## **What You Should Bring:**

In addition to the food and treats for your party, you should bring tablecloths, plates, silverware and any other decorations you'd like to put up in the lobby. To help protect the paint on our walls, please use either blue painter's tape, sticky tack, or special Scotch tape meant for walls for any decorations. Please remember to bring a lighter for your birthday candles. **NO** pinatas allowed. If you want to bring helium balloons, they must stay in the lobby or foyer only. Backdrops in the studio are fine.

## **Dance Party Portion:**

The dance and games portion of the party is either 45 or 60 minutes (the dance party portion for ages 5 & under is 45 minutes in the dance room, and 60 minutes in the dance room for ages 6 & up). The party will begin at your appointed time, with approximately 5 minutes of open dancing with balloons as your guests arrive. The party will then continue, according to the theme you have chosen, and will include movement instruction, dance games, and fun with props like the parachute, hula hoops, and more, including a dance obstacle course.

## **Food, Cake or Craft:**

You will have the use of the lobby for 30 minutes after the dance party portion concludes. If you are choosing to serve food or treats, please let us know. Some families choose to send home treats instead of serving them. If you would prefer to use the 30 minutes in the lobby for a themed craft project, that is an option! (Craft supplies are provided by the party family).

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### **RSVPs & Payments:**

Please let us know your final party RSVP head count 7 days prior to your party. The party will be billed to your account at that time, and payment is due prior to your party day.

### **What the Guests Should Wear:**

Your child and their guests should wear clothing that is comfortable and easy to move in (dance clothes if they want, but not required!). They may wear dance shoes, or if they do not have any, they should be barefoot or in socks with grippers on the bottom. NO STREET SHOES are allowed in the dance rooms. Any parents entering the dance room will need to remove their shoes as well.
